



## Mayors Endorse Tim Scott for Congress

Three Lowcountry Mayors have officially endorsed Tim Scott's candidacy for Congress, citing his core principles that will help bring America back on course.

The three, Mt. Pleasant Mayor Billy Swails, Goose Creek Mayor Mike Heitzler, and Lincolnville Mayor Tyrone Aiken, each noted that they had worked with Scott in the past, and were impressed by his deeply held convictions.
